

## Testimony 2:

I am M. Nabuh, the mother of two children (6 and 8) enrolled at the National Protestant College, Kfarshima. Our family lives in Choueifat, an area that became increasingly dangerous during the recent war.

We were forced to leave and relocate temporarily to a safer area. During this period, our apartment was damaged by nearby attacks. Windows shattered, furniture was damaged, and parts of the house became unsafe to use. Since then, we have not been able to return home, as repairs and safety inspections are still needed.

During this difficult time, the support we received through the National Evangelical Church of Beirut brought us much-needed relief. Our family received a voucher valued at 100 USD to purchase food and basic necessities from the supermarket.

This assistance helped us provide groceries and essential items for our children while coping with displacement and financial stress. More importantly, this support reminded us that we were not alone. The kindness and solidarity shown to our family gave us comfort and hope during a time filled with fear and uncertainty.
